Village of Trenton Sales Tax Question

“Shall the Chairman and Trustees of the Village of Trenton, Nebraska, impose a sales and use tax of 1.5% (one and one-half percent) upon the same transactions within the Village of Trenton, Nebraska, on which the State of Nebraska is authorized to impose a tax, with the proceeds collected therefrom to be used to provide tax relief through the application of sales tax proceeds to the infrastructure, streets, economic development, bonded indebtedness of the village, the infrastructure, streets, economic development, bonded indebtedness and general property tax relief of the Village and shall the Village increase its budgeted restricted fund for fiscal year 2019-2020 by \$90,000.00 (27.95%) over the current years restricted fund?”

- FOR said sales and use tax

Village of Stratton Sales Tax Question

“Shall the Governing Body of the Village of Stratton, Nebraska, impose a sales and use tax of two percent (2%) upon the same transactions within the Village of Stratton on which the State of Nebraska is authorized to impose a tax commencing January 1, 2019, with the proceeds collected therefrom to be used to provide tax relief through the application of sales tax proceeds to the infrastructure, streets, economic development, bonded indebtedness and general property tax relief of the Village and shall the Village increase its budgeted restricted fund for fiscal year 2019-2020 by \$31,600.00 (19.18%) over the current years restricted fund?”
