Hitchcock County Board of Commissioners

Trenton, Nebraska

January 7th, 2019

A meeting of the County Board of Commissioners of Hitchcock County, Nebraska was held at the Hitchcock County Courthouse Commissioner's Room, 229 East D Street, Trenton, Nebraska on Monday, the 7th, day of January, 2019 commencing at 9:00 o'clock a.m. Present were Chair Scott McDonald, Commissioners Paul Nichols and Ron Wertz, and County Clerk Margaret Pollmann. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in the Hitchcock County News, the designated method for giving notice. Board agendas are posted on the County's website www.hitchcockcounty.ne.gov. Notice of the meeting was given to the Chair and all members of the Board. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public. The Open Meetings Act was available for review and Chair indicated the location of such copy in the room where the meeting was being held.

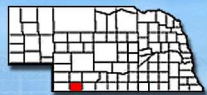
Chair McDonald called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

The floor was opened for nominations for Chair for calendar year 2019. Member McDonald nominated Paul Nichols. The nomination was seconded by Wertz. There were no further nominations and nominations ceased. The roll was called on the nomination of Paul Nichols for Chair for calendar year 2019 and the following members voted in favor of said nomination: Wertz and McDonald. Member Nichols abstained. Motion carried and Paul Nichols was declared Chair for 2019.

The floor was opened for nominations for Vice Chair for calendar year 2019. Member McDonald nominated Ron Wertz. The nomination was seconded by Nichols. There were no further nominations and nominations ceased. The roll was called on the nomination of Ron Wertz for Vice Chair for calendar year 2019 and the following members voted in favor of said nomination: Nichols and McDonald. Member Wertz abstained. Motion carried and Ron Wertz was declared Vice Chair for 2019.

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Member McDonald seconded the motion and after consideration the following members voted in favor of said motion. Nichols, Wertz, and McDonald. Motion carried.

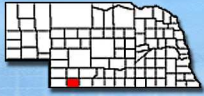

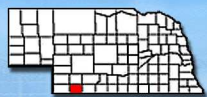

RESOLUTION #19-1

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioner's of Hitchcock County, Nebraska, that during the year 2019 and for all remainder of the term of Jackie Drain, as County Treasurer and Margaret M. Pollmann, as County Clerk ex officio Clerk of the District Court, or until further directed by the Board, that the following named banks shall be depositories for the funds of Hitchcock County, Nebraska:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that since the County Treasurer and County Clerk/Clerk of the District Court have on hand and will have on hand from time to time for deposit, County money which should be deposited for safekeeping in these banks in excess of the paid-up capital stock and surplus of each of the said banks, but shall not at any time have in said banks County funds in excess of 90% of the bonds deposited by each bank as security plus the \$100,000.00 demand deposit and the \$100,000.00 time deposit covered and protected by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation of which the bank is a licensed and qualified member thereof. In the event of demand deposits, for the Hitchcock County Clerk's Imprest Fund being over \$100,000.00 the receiving bank will furnish securities to cover the additional deposits. Provided that the



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aforesaid banks each and all of them meet the requirement imposed by the laws of the State of Nebraska regarding property bond and securities for the deposits made in said banks.

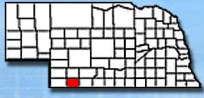

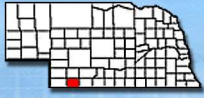

RESOLUTION #19-4

WHEREAS, the County of Hitchcock, Nebraska, (hereinafter called COUNTY) is a political subdivision of the State of Nebraska; and



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WHEREAS, pursuant to NEB. REV. STAT. §23-106 (1), the Hitchcock County Board of Commissioners shall manage the COUNTY's funds and COUNTY business, except as otherwise specifically provided; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY is desirous of adopting a Banking Resolution for banking transactions by and between the COUNTY, acting by and through its various officers and the Community First Bank (hereinafter called BANK) 339 Main Street, PO Box 338, Trenton, Nebraska.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF HITCHCOCK COUNTY, NEBRASKA:

1. That the BANK is hereby designated as a depository for funds of the COUNTY and also for the funds of other persons or entities coming into the hands of the COUNTY's officials pursuant to their official duties, and that the elected or appointed officials of said COUNTY as specifically designated herein, and each of them, hereby are authorized to open or otherwise maintain such account(s) with the BANK, as said elected or appointed officials deem necessary to carry out their respective official duties on behalf of and for the COUNTY, and to execute such agreements as shall be required by the BANK and subject to rules and regulations of the BANK governing such accounts.
2. That, subject to the special instructions set forth herein, if any, or as otherwise authorized by law, any of the following persons are authorized and empowered to deal generally with the BANK with respect to the following specified accounts:

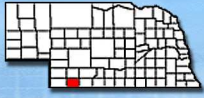

and to designate from time to time themselves and such other deputy official(s) to (1) sign, on behalf of the COUNTY, checks, drafts or withdrawal orders drawn upon such accounts; and (2) to endorse in the name of the COUNTY and to deposit in such accounts money, checks and other instruments for payment of moneys, which endorsements may be by stamp without designation of the person endorsing, and in connection therewith certify to the BANK the specimen signatures on any signature card.

3. That notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, the BANK is authorized to honor instruments for the payment from, and to charge the same to, the Hitchcock County Imprest Fund # XXX-XX8 account ONLY upon proper authorized signature(s) of:
 - A) one (1) County Commissioner, as either chairman or vice-chairman or acting chairman, AND
 - B) the County Clerk or Deputy County Clerk.
4. That of the COUNTY, checks, drafts or money orders when signed by those persons so designated, whether or not (1) payable or endorsed to the person signing; or (2) paid or applied for the benefit of the persons signing.
5. That this resolution shall be certified to the BANK together with specimen signatures of the persons named herein and said certification shall continue in force until express written notice of rescission or modification has been received by the BANK.
6. That the original signature card(s) pertaining to said accounts of the COUNTY and bearing the true specimen signature(s) of the persons named and otherwise authorized hereby shall be on file with the BANK.

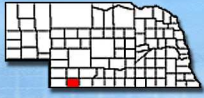

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Member Wertz moved to appoint Dustin Ladenburger, Wayne Merrill, and Tom Monnahan each to three (3) year terms (expiring 1-22) on the Hitchcock County Planning Commission. Member Nichols seconded the motion and after consideration, the following members voted in favor of the motion: Nichols, Wertz and McDonald. Motion carried.

Member McDonald moved to appoint Robert Brown to a three year term (expiring 1-22) as alternate on the Hitchcock County Planning Commission. Member Wertz seconded the motion and after consideration, the following members voted in favor of the motion: Wertz, McDonald and Nichols. Motion carried.

Member Nichols moved to appoint Robert Brown and Jacob Miller to three year terms (expiring 1-22) on the Hitchcock County Board of Adjustment. Member Wertz seconded the motion and after consideration, the following members voted in favor of the motion. McDonald, Wertz, and Nichols. Motion carried.

Pursuant to NEB. REV. STAT. §23-1114.09 “The salary of one full-time deputy of the various county offices shall not be less than sixty-five percent of the county officer’s salary.” The Board finds that all Hitchcock County Chief deputy base salaries are in compliance with said statute.

Member Wertz moved to direct Chair to execute the Memorandum of Understanding for Appointment of Hitchcock County Surveyor by and between the County and Brian Langenberg. Member McDonald seconded the motion and after consideration, the following members voted in favor of the motion: Nichols, Wertz and McDonald. Motion carried.

Highway Superintendent Phillip Dixon joined the meeting. Discussion was held on the 2019 Employment Contract of Phillip W. Dixon for highway superintendent services and the appointment of Hitchcock County Highway Superintendent for 2019.

Member Wertz moved to appoint Phillip W. Dixon as Hitchcock County Highway Superintendent and to direct Chair to execute the 2019 Employment Contract with Phillip W. Dixon for calendar year 2019. Member McDonald seconded the motion and after consideration, the following members voted in favor of the motion: McDonald, Wertz and Nichols. Motion carried.

Various road and bridge projects were discussed. Preliminary discussion on the One & Six Year Road Plan was had.

The Treasurer was in receipt of \$113.57 from Village of Palisade, \$138.49 from McCook Public Schools, \$423.81 from MRNRD, and \$315.77 from Village of Stratton, for election expenses, \$50.00 from State of NE for land lease sale room rent, and \$91.27 from Central Crude for oil production, all credited to the General Fund; \$2.00 from Level 3 Communications, \$1.00 from Vonage America, and \$1.00 from Hughes Network Systems for 911 surcharges; \$633.00 from Roger Lewis for a culvert, credited to the Road Fund.

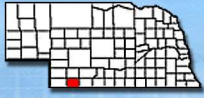
The Sheriff’s Fourth Quarter 2018 Report was on file.
