QUESTION:

"Shall the governing body of the incorporated municipality impose a one and one-half percent (1.5%) Sales and Use Tax upon the same transactions within such municipality on which the State of Nebraska is authorized to impose a tax, for the purpose of establishing a Trenton Improvement Fund to assist in the replacement and repair of infrastructure, streets, economic development, parks & recreation, bonded indebtedness within the village limits of Trenton, Nebraska, and the reduction of any public debt previously incurred by the Village of Trenton, Nebraska for any of the aforementioned infrastructure, streets, economic development, parks & recreation, bonded indebtedness improvements, commencing April 1, 2023 and continuing for a period of fifteen (15) years?"
