

NOTICE TO NON-PARTISAN VOTERS

A registered voter who is not affiliated with a political party and who desires to vote in the primary election for the offices of United States Senator & Representative in Congress District may request a partisan ballot for any one of the four state recognized political parties pursuant to NEB. REV. STAT. §32-912(3). The Nebraska Democratic, Libertarian and Legal Marijuana NOW Parties have opened their 2022 Primary election pursuant to NEB. REV. STAT. §32-912(2) to allow nonpartisan voters to vote on any race where their party is nominating a candidate for a partisan office.

WHAT THIS MEANS

A Non-Partisan voter requesting a Non-Partisan Republican ballot will be voting for Representative In Congress District 03 only.

A Non-Partisan voter requesting a Non-Partisan Democratic, Non-Partisan Libertarian, or Non-Partisan Legal Marijuana NOW ballot will vote on all partisan contests for the aforementioned political parties.

No such registered nonpartisan voter shall receive more than one such described partisan ballot.
