Member Wertz moved to approve the Application To Occupy County Road Right of Way filed by Murfin Drilling Co. for an underground electric line in the NW ¼ NE ¼ Section 26-2-32. RESOLUTION 18-21

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Board of Commissioners, Hitchcock County, Nebraska, that for the purpose of transferring money from the General Fund to the County Road Fund per the supporting schedule of transfers budgeted found in the County Budget, that the board directs the County Treasurer to transfer any Road Fund monies collected from the 2018 levy, which is a designated portion of the General levy for 2018, and that this transfer would occur by the Treasurer after each months collections have been calculated.

The designated portion from the 2018 County levy for the Road Fund is .154057 and the General Fund is .082758

The County Board believes that this is the most accurate way to keep track of Road Fund and General Fund revenues.
