A meeting of the County Board of Commissioners of Hitchcock County, Nebraska was held at the Hitchcock County Courthouse Commissioner's Room, 229 East D Street, Trenton, Nebraska on Monday, the 4th, day of February, 2019 commencing at 9:00 o'clock a.m. Present were Chair Paul Nichols, Commissioners Scott McDonald and Ron Wertz, and County Clerk Margaret Pollmann. Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in the Hitchcock County News, the designated method for giving notice. Board agendas are posted on the County's website www.hitchcockcounty.ne.gov. Notice of the meeting was given to the Chair and all members of the Board. All proceedings hereafter shown where taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public. Attorney Garner joined the meeting. Discussion held on Tax Equalization and Review Commission (T.E.R.C.) Case No. 17R-0103.

Treasurer Jackie Drain joined the meeting and advised as to a \$15.00 balance in 2018 CDBG Owner Occupied Rehabilitation Funds.

Motion by Wertz by to de-obligate Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) income/funds received in 2018 currently held in the County Treasurer's CDBG Bank Account in the amount of \$15.00. The motion was seconded by McDonald and after consideration, the following members voted in favor of the motion. Nichols, Wertz, and McDonald. Motion carried.

Motion by McDonald to direct County Treasurer to transfer former CDBG income funds, de-obligated this date, in the amount of \$15.00, to the County's General Fund to be designated for future housing opportunities within Hitchcock County. The motion was seconded by Nichols and after consideration, the following members voted in favor of the motion: McDonald, Wertz, and Nichols. Motion carried.

Dennis Maggart, Executive Vice President of McInnes Group, Inc. advised as to the upcoming health insurance renewal. Extensive discussion held on available options.

Member Wertz moved to adopt the Blue Cross and Blue Shield Blue Pride BHA19N H.S.A. Bronze – Embedded health insurance plan for the period March 1, 2019 to February 28, 2020. Member McDonald seconded the motion and after consideration, the following members voted in favor of the motion. Wertz, McDonald, and Nichols. Motion carried.

Member McDonald moved to set the County Health Reimbursement Arrangement (HRA) contribution at \$2,000.00 for a single policy and \$4,000.00 for an employee spouse/employee child(ren) policy beginning March 1, 2019. Member Wertz seconded the motion and after consideration, the following members voted in favor of the motion: Nichols, Wertz, and McDonald. Motion carried.
