A meeting of the County Board of Commissioners of Hitchcock County, Nebraska was held at the Hitchcock County Courthouse Commissioner's Room, 229 East D Street, Trenton, Nebraska on Monday the 21st day of October 2024 commencing at 9:00 o'clock a.m. Present were Chair Paul Nichols, Commissioners Ron Wertz and Scott McDonald and County Clerk Margaret Pollmann. RESOLUTION NO. 24-20

WHEREAS the County of Hitchcock, Nebraska, is a political subdivision of the State of Nebraska; and

WHEREAS, on September 3^{rd} , 2024, the County adopted the 2024/2025 Hitchcock County Budget; and

WHEREAS, the County Board budgeted the expenditure of inheritance tax funds during the 2024/2025 fiscal year as follows: \$700,000.00 to the General Fund and \$300,000.00 to the Road Fund to reduce the property tax request to be transferred as necessary to meet current expenditures.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the County Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to immediately transfer the sum of \$100,000.00 from the Inheritance Tax Fund to the County Road Fund for the purpose of meeting current expenditures.

RESOLUTION 24-19

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Board of Commissioners, Hitchcock County, Nebraska, that for the purpose of transferring money from the General Fund to the County Road Fund per the supporting schedule of transfers budgeted found in the County Budget, that the Board directs the County Treasurer to transfer as needed and available a portion of the monies collected pursuant to the General levy for 2024 to the Road Fund, and that said transfer(s) be made by the County Treasurer after collections have been calculated.

The total portion from the 2024 County General levy to be transferred to the Road Fund is .294821 not to exceed \$608,679.00 for the budget year ended June 30, 2025.

The County Board believes that this is the most accurate way to keep track of Road Fund and General Fund revenues.
